

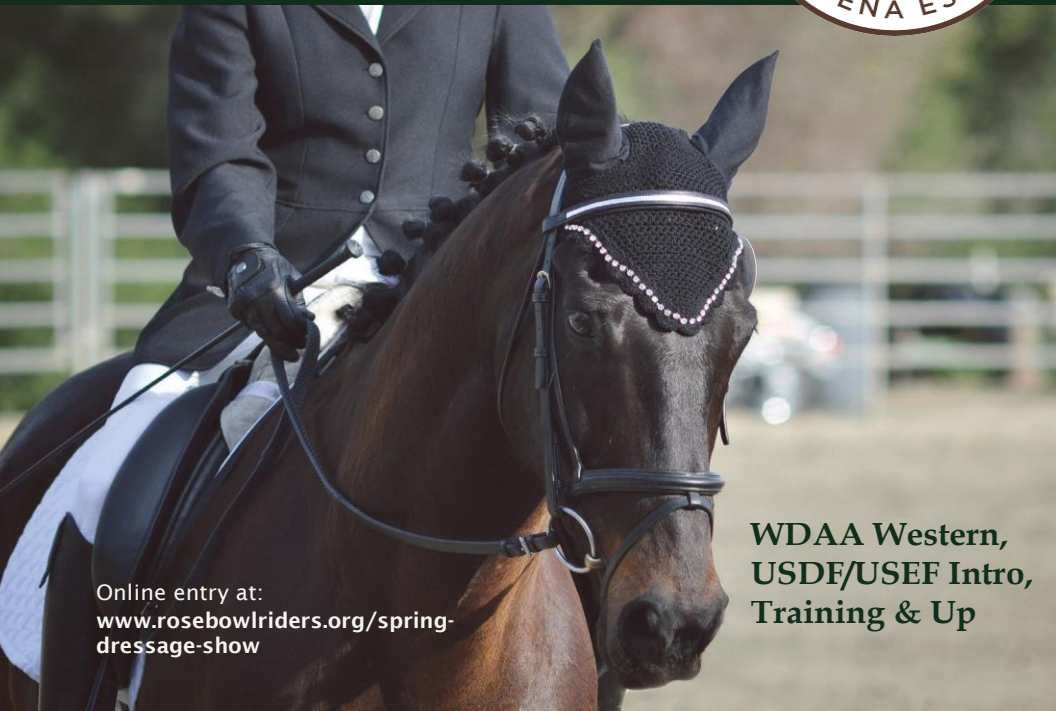

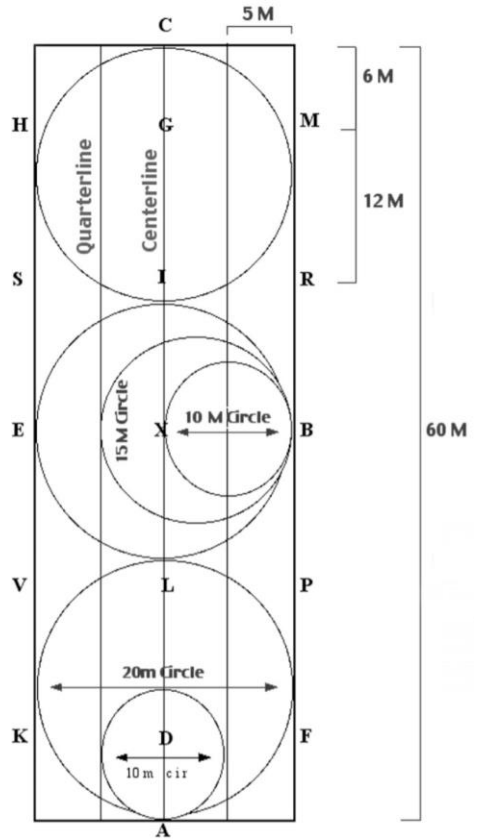

-All tests will be ridden in a 20 x 60 meter court with sand footing.

-All tests may be called or ridden from memory. You must provide your own caller or notify the show manager in advance if you would like us to provide a caller for you.

-Mailed entries must be postmarked by May 3, online entries completed by May 7. Payment must accompany all entries – Online and Mailed.

-Refunds will be given in the event your ride cannot be scheduled.

***WESTERN** may not cross enter into any other division/level.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: PLEASE READ ENTIRELY

1. Show will operate in accordance with United States Equestrian Federation rules.
2. Any rider not in control of their mount or disruptive to other riders may be asked to leave the arena.
3. All decisions of judges and show committee are final.
4. If you are late or are dismissed because of conduct you will not receive a refund.
5. There is a \$25.00 charge if the bank for any reason returns your check.
6. A youth exhibitor is a rider under 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2024. A parent or guardian must sign for all youth exhibitors.
7. An ATSM/SEI approved riding helmet is required for all youth exhibitors.
8. Dogs shall be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Dogs may not be tied to tie rails. The following breeds are not permitted on the premises: Rottweiler, Pit Bull Terrier, Doberman, Akita, Chow and mixes thereof.
9. All horses must be sound.
10. Braiding is optional.
11. Payment must accompany all entries.
12. No refunds will be given after May 3rd except with a veterinarian's note.
13. Refunds will be given in the event your ride cannot be scheduled.
14. Scratches may be filled at show management's discretion.
15. Approved whips and spurs may be used per USEF guidelines.
16. For Introductory and Training through Second Level tests, a plain snaffle bridle is required with either a regular cavesson, a dropped, flash or crossed noseband.
17. Martingales, bit guards and any kind of boots or bandages are not allowed.
18. Numbers must be worn at all times when in the arena.
19. All riders, showing or schooling, must have signed a release at the show office.
20. For Western WDAA tests, standard western show attire & tack is permitted. Bits with shanks over 8.5 inches are not permitted.
21. All riders/trainers/parents are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship.
22. All riders, exhibitors *and* their guardians must sign an ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT.

Recognizing and agreeing that horse sports may be DANGEROUS AND HAZARDOUS ENDEAVORS, EVEN LEADING TO PERMANENT INJURY OR DEATH, the undersigned, as owner, rider, spectator or other participants and/or parent or legal guardian of and owner, rider or spectator or other participant collectively (owner) knowingly and expressly ASSUMES ANY AND ALL RISKS of loss or bodily injury and AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, REGARDLESS OF NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS, ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC., its organizing committee, directors, members, agents and employees, and any instructor of ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC., and his or her employees, or employees thereof (collectively “ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC.”). Each owner shall indemnify ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC. against all claims or demands of any nature that may grow out of an injury occasioned by a horse or arise from the negligence of the person(s) in charge of such horse.

In addition to the above ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT, the undersigned knowingly and expressly RELEASES ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC. OF ANY ACTS OF NEGLIGENCE, WHETHER ACTIVE OR PASSIVE.

This Agreement is made on behalf of the undersigned, and any guest or relative of the undersigned, including minor children or wards thereof. The agreement to HOLD HARMLESS shall include the payment of any attorney’s fees, and shall include the reimbursement to ROSE BOWL RIDERS, INC. arising out of the loss or damage to the property of the undersigned, including any guests, relatives, minor children, or wards thereof, from any cause whatsoever. THE UNDERSIGNED RECOGNIZES AND AGREES THAT BY EXECUTING THIS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT, HE OR SHE IS WAIVING AND RELEASING VALUABLE LEGAL RIGHTS.
